

Bushey & District Synagogue, Bushey Heath, Hertfordshire

Project Description

- New Heating system and pipe work
 - Electrical wiring throughout
 - Intruder and fire alarm system
- New kitchen with industrial extract system
 - New toilets with extract system
- Acoustic partition panels for easy separation of main area
- Carpeting and vinyl throughout

The refurbishment of this existing Synagogue was undertaken in three phases to allow the building to remain in use throughout. The main challenge was the second Phase of works which had to be completed by the start of the Jewish New Year which meant working to a tight programme with no room for extension. As it is practice to refrain from turning electricity on or off during the Jewish Sabbath, the lighting and heating systems were installed with a time clock to allow for this religious law to be observed.
