Project Description

- Strip out of existing partitions, glazing and floor finishes
 - Modification of existing M&E/installation of new
 - New floor finishes
- Installation of specialist sprung raised floor to gym area
 - New bespoke glazed partitions
- Installation of glass and solid core doors/ironmongery
 - Full restaurant capacity kitchen
 - Installation of micro kitchens within restaurant area
 - New data cabling
 - Bespoke joinery
 - New fire alarm and fire curtain
 - New access control and cameras
 - Two comms rooms
 - LED signage

This was the first phase of fit out works to Google's new London office. The design included a theme reflecting Brighton beach, with meeting rooms constructed in the style of beach huts, dodgem cars and iconic digital artwork. Red telephone booths and rolling dice serving as video conferencing pods were also built into the workspace.

Specialist areas were incorporated within the office, including a gym, restaurant and catering kitchen, games area and meeting/training facilities.
